Workshop on AquaCrop model



The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, FAO, will organize a one week workshop/training course on the Aquacrop model, together with Bioforsk, IWMI and other ClimaRice II partners in February 2011.

The workshop on AquaCrop will be organized from the 14- 18th of February in Hyderabad, India. About 20 participants including managers from the Irrigation and CAD Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, the Water Resources Organization, Government of Tamil Nadu and scientists will take part in the workshop. The training programme is based on a request from the Irrigation and CAD Department of the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

AquaCrop is a crop water productivity model developed by the Land and Water Division of FAO. It simulates yield response to water of herbaceous crops, and is particularly suited to address conditions where water is a key limiting factor in crop production.
