Stakeholder workshop in Nam Dinh province

The main purpose was to share project results and evaluate the relevance results for scaling up in Nam Dinh province (in particular tested saline tolerant rice varieties; results from the use of slow release nitrogen fertilisers; soil management and mitigation/ and reducing GHGs; socio-economic vulnerability assessment and Gender). Several stakeholders including officials from MARD and DARD (Nam Dinh), private sector, farmers organization representatives participated and actively took part in the discussions. The stakeholders and farmers were of the view that the results presented are very relevant for the province and in particular the coastal areas in Nam Dinh severely affected by salinity. However, these results have to be further tested and approved before the final recommendations can be given. Climaviet is a small initiative and hence cooperation with other agencies like WINROCK working in the province can be mutually beneficial. Potential cooperation between VAAS-Bioforsk and Winrock International Organization, and local authorities to disseminate project results was discussed. Ms.Elin Ullebø, the First Secretary from the Royal Norwegian Embassy, Hanoi, expressed that the embassy was quite satisfied with the results achieved so far in ClimaViet.
